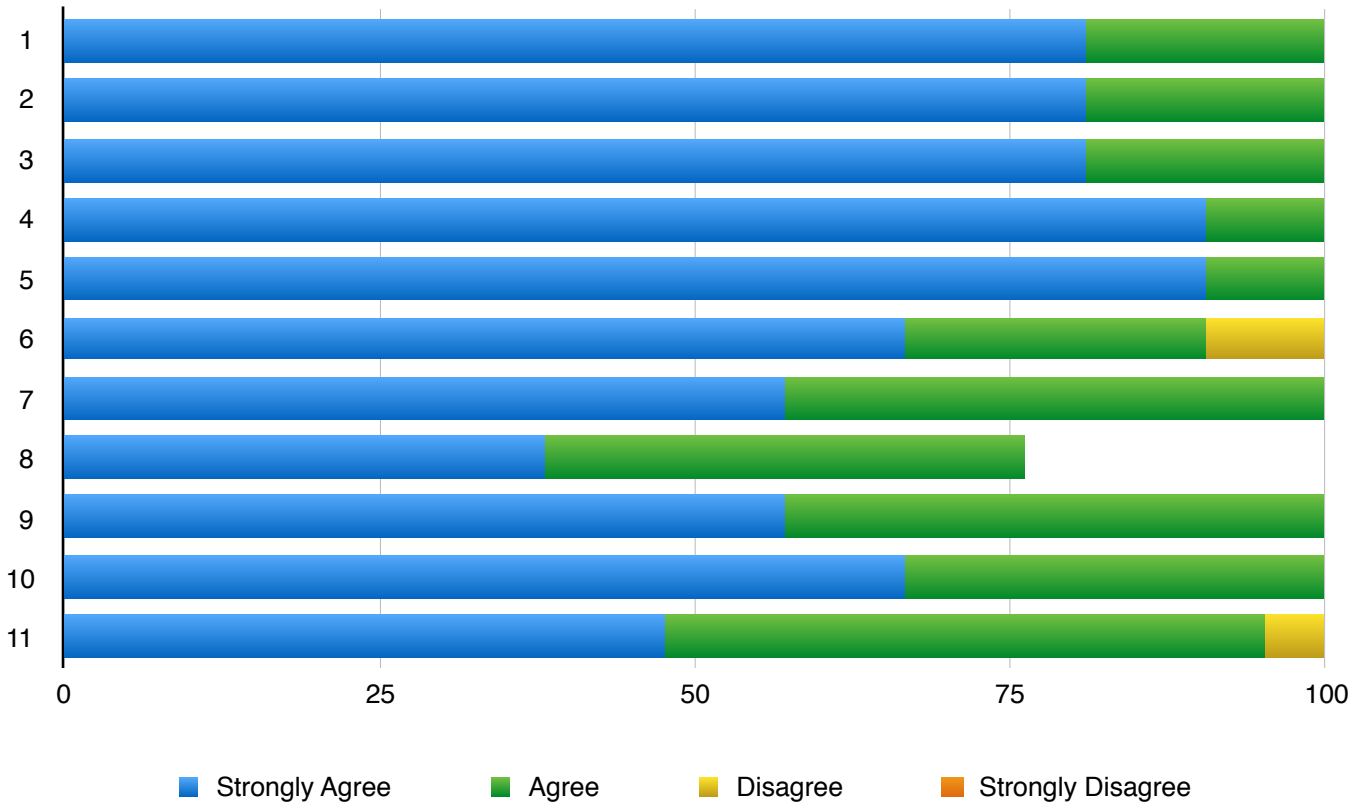


Parent Survey November 2018

This survey was sent to parents in mid November 2018. There were 21 respondents. Each survey asked 11 questions (204 possible responses).

Question Level Analysis



1	My child is happy at this school
2	My child feels safe at this school
3	My child makes good progress at this school
4	My child is well looked after at this school
5	My child is taught well at this school
6	My child receives appropriate homework for their age
7	This school ensures the pupils are well behaved
8	This school deals effectively with bullying

Commentary

- Wistanstow CE Primary School is a happy and safe place to be and learn
- Children make good progress at Wistanstow
- Parents believe that teaching is good or better
- Behaviour is good or better
- Bullying is dealt with effectively
- A very small proportion of respondents believe we do not provide age appropriate homework - no further explanation was provided.
- Leadership is effective
- 100% of respondents would recommend this school to others
