Room Temperature Checks

To reassure you we are all working within safe temperature ranges despite the doors and windows being open we can confirm that we have recorded temperatures between 17.2°C and 20.8°C. These readings were taken towards the end of each day. Advice from sources, such as teaching unions, suggest 16°C as a reasonable minimum and 13°C in areas involving physical effort. We are well above this minimum

The guidance we are obliged to follow is supplied by the DFE and we are monitored in its application by the Local Authority and Health & Safety Executive. It is our understanding that the issue of ventilation versus temperature in the coming months is under review at the DfE at the moment and we have been promised further guidance imminently. It has also been raised at recent head's meetings with the Local Authority and has been escalated as a matter of urgency with the DFE (from Shropshire and beyond) That said, we will always do what is reasonably practicable to provide a safe and comfortable learning environment.
