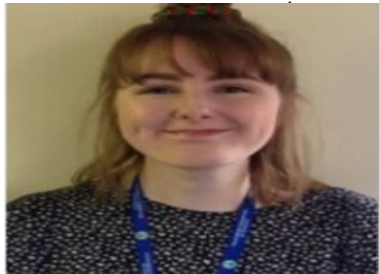
WELCOME

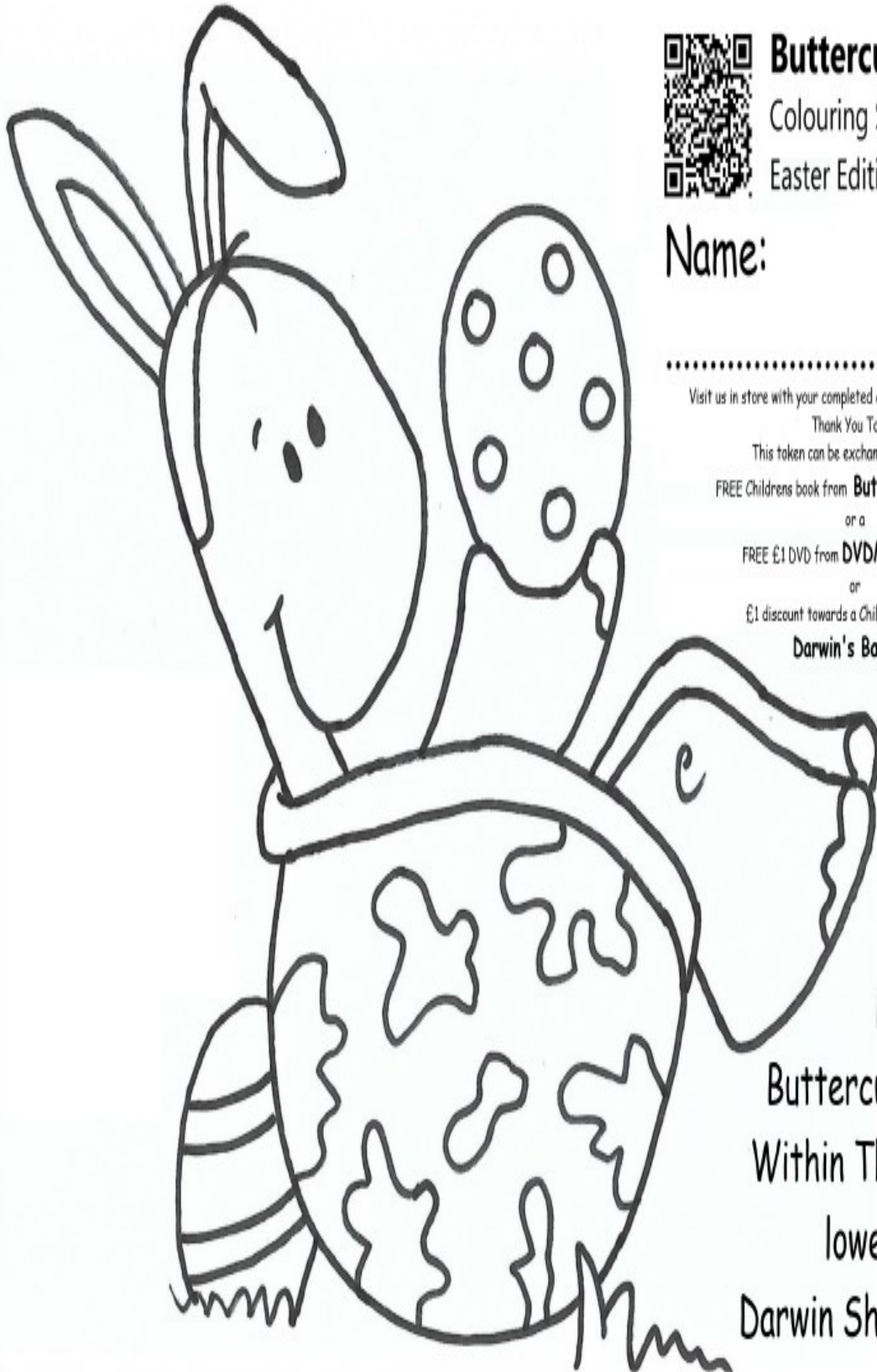
