Pupils took part in a wide range of sporting activities and competitions in 2024-25. Transport to sporting fixtures and events for all pupils was paid from sports fund.

Specialist sports coaches supported school staff to deliver PE curriculum lessons, as well as leading activities and competitive inter- and intra- school competitions.

Girls took part in a “This Girl Can” event and pupils with particular needs took part in specialist events such as a Boccia tournament. All pupils were included in every activity offered in school.

All pupils had the opportunity to take part in a variety of after school sports clubs.

100% of pupils leaving from Year 6 were able to swim 25m securely.

An emergency repair to the playground surface (the school’s only outdoor area), which had become unusable, had to be undertaken in order to enable pupils to take part in any sporting activities.
